Payment Terms and Options

School Fee Statements are emailed out to all families at the start of each term. Payment Terms are 14 days from the date of your Statement. For those families that wish to pay upfront in one payment for the whole year, a **\$50 discount** will be deducted from the total amount owing. Payment must be made by the due date of Term 1 fees.

Payment Options are Direct Debit or Credit Card Authority, BPay, Eftpos, Cash or Cheque. Direct Debit and Credit Card Authority forms are available from the office, on the school website or Parent Portal.

A new Direct Debit or Credit Card Authority form must be completed each year.

Families unable to make payments by the due date must make arrangements with the Principal. Where reminder notices are persistently ignored or arrangements to pay arrears are not kept, the school will pursue legal action to recover outstanding fees.

The school is supportive of families in difficult financial circumstances and a concessions process is available for needy families. The process includes a confidential application to have fees and levies discounted for the school year. A new application must be submitted at the start of each school year.

Capital Levy	This is a compulsory levy charged per family. It is used to help meet the
	maintenance and refurbishment costs of current facilities together with
	contributions to the cost of current and future commitments of building projects
P&F Levy	This levy has been determined by the St William's Parents and Friends Advisory
	Group and is used to assist the school to improve resources and facilities. Funds
	also contribute to school events run by the Group.
Student Levy	This levy includes but not limited to:

Booklist Levy	This levy covers the booklist items (eg stationery) that are delivered to the school in

IT Access Levy	This levy relates to the purchase and maintenance of digital technologies, software,

Gala Sports Levy	Gala sport for Years 3 to 6 held normally in Term 3 (however circumstances may
	change this date) and forms part of the school sports program. The levy is used to
	offset the cost of buses and hire of fields to the relevant sporting grounds.
Instrumental Music Program	The music program is an extra curriculum program and is open to Years 4 to 6
	students to participate in lessons, which includes being part of our Junior and Senior
	school bands.
